Talking With an Insurance Adjustor

If you've been in a car accident, you will be contacted by both an adjustor from your insurance company and an adjustor from the other party's insurance company. Both adjustors are trying to minimize the amount of money their company will pay. Follow this tip sheet to be sure that you do not jeopardize your personal injury claim during these phone interviews.

DO'S:

1. Write down the name, address and telephone number of the insurance adjustor and the insurance company along with the claim number.
2. Provide your full name, address and telephone number.
3. Take notes of the conversation.
4. Ask the adjustor if they are aware of any witnesses.
5. Be very general when you describe your injuries. Tell the adjustor you will provide a complete, detailed list of injuries after your doctors have done a full assessment. Oftentimes medical injuries do not manifest themselves for days or even weeks after the accident.

DON'T'S:

1. Do not agree to an audio tape recording of the conversation.
2. Insurance adjustors will engage you in an informal conversation in an effort to get you to relax and get as many details about the accident as possible. Do not discuss anything but the basic facts of the accident:
 - A. Where the accident occurred.
 - B. Date and time of the accident.
 - C. Type of accident; i.e., motorcycle, motor vehicle, slip and fall, etc.
3. You do not need to provide details about your work such as income, schedule or details of what you do at your job.
4. Do not agree to anything.
5. Do not sign anything.
6. Don't answer family questions. You are no obligation to give information about your family.
7. You are not obligated at this point to identify witnesses.
8. You are not obligated to give the adjustor the name of your doctor. ■
